### 2 Year Olds

This half term we have welcomed back new and old friends.

We have been learning the routines of the day and working on becoming more independent. We have been practising taking off our shoes and pulling our trousers up and down to help with care routines.

The children have enjoyed exploring our key texts, Owl Babies and Goldilocks and the Three Bears. They have enjoyed re-telling the story and exploring the concept of size.

We have learnt a variety of rhymes this half term, our favourite being, 'Incy Wincy Spider'.

We have explored spiders, searched for webs and watched spiders carefully as they move.

The children have shown an interest in role playing in the home corner.

We have talked about our families; who is in our family and the special people who live in our house.







## 3-4 Year Olds

This half term we have enjoyed welcoming everyone back and getting to know new friends.

We have been learning the routines of the day and working on our independence skills. We have been practising getting ready for outdoor play by taking off our shoes, putting on a waterproof before finally getting a pair of wellingtons on.

Our key text, 'Families, Families' has promoted lots of lovely discussion and it has been wonderful to welcome both JJ's Grandad and Bobby's Mummy and baby brother, Leo, into school.

We have learnt a variety of rhymes this half term with our favourite being, 'Hokey Cokey'. The children have enjoyed finding alternative rhyming words and learning new ring games.

The children have shown an interest in floating and sinking, ice cream shops and have also engaged in some wonderful problem solving when discovering how far the cars can travel along the ramps!

You will have the opportunity to stay with your child to see what they are doing in nursery, play alongside them, observe the way that staff talk to them, as well as see how independent they are. 
