2 Year Olds

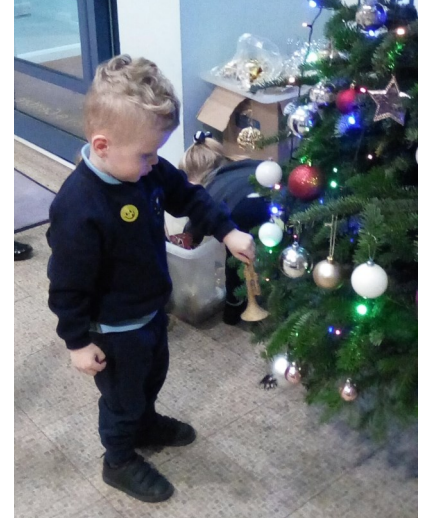
